. The status of the scanning by vends has been reviewed by Commissioner (Excise) and following action points has been decided henceforth:

- 1. Manual receiving of T.P.s will be stopped from 15.02.2018, all licensees are directed to receive the T.P.s /stock strictly through ESCIMS only.
- 2. Actual physical quantity of stock of liquor as on 31.01.2018 be collected by each private/corporation vend and General Managers of the respective corporations will ensure to send consolidated report to Excise Department for record purpose.
- 3. Inventory of liquor at the particular vend showing against the category of stock take sold strictly be cleared by 15.03.2018. Any inventory found against stock take sold beyond 15.03.2018 will be confiscated by the Department and the licensee will attract a penal action.
- 4. Department will consider the legitimate sale of liquor only sale made through scanning. All the Incharge of liquor vends are directed to put their system in place to ensure 100% sale through scanning after 15.02.2018.
- 5. Sale of Liquor without scanning will attract penal action as per terms and conditions of the licence.
