ORDER

The reference is invited to the **Standard Operating Procedure (SOP)** for the Distilleries/Wineries/Breweries in which the standards and specification of the barcode to be pasted on the liquor bottles and the case has been specified. It has been noticed that some of the Distilleries/Wineries/Breweries and the foreign liquor suppliers are not following the standards and specifications as specified by the department which results into problem in scanning of the bottles at the time of sale. This hampers and delays the process of the sale.

It is now informed to all the Distilleries/Wineries/Breweries and the foreign liquor suppliers that in case of complaint from any user regarding problem in scanning of the bar code, the license of the concerned Distilleries/Wineries/Breweries and the foreign liquor suppliers shall be suspended immediately.

All concerned are therefore again directed to comply with the standards and specification of the bar code as specified by the department.
