I am pleased to intimate that Govt. of NCT of Delhi vide Cabinet Decision No. 2410 dated 17.08.2016 has decided to change the charging point of excise duty from existing transport permit level to Transit Transport Permit (TTP) level and the excise duty is to be deposited by the L-1F licencee when TTP applied w.e.f. 14.10.2016.

To make it a success, the co-operation of all the stake holder is essential, therefore, the likely steps need to be taken are as under:

- Ail the L-1F Licencee have to keep adequate provisions of money in their bank account to deposit the excise duty at TTP level so the TTP are approved without any difficulty to facilitate the transit of liquor from custom warehouse so adequate and continuous liquor is supplied to retail licencees without any difficulty.
- The Excise Duty on the stock lying on 14.10.2016 with L-1F licencee is to be deposited, therefore, the bank account of L-1F licencee attached with ESCIMS should have adequate amount for the Excise Duty.
- The L-1F licencee shall ensure that atleast one week stock is maintained in BWH to have adequate and continuous supply to liquor to avoid any untoward incident otherwise strict punitive action under Rule 89 of Delhi Excise Rules,2010 shall be taken.
