ORDER

Whereas, in pursuance to the guidelines issued by the Chairperson, State Executive Committee, Delhi Disaster Management Authority, GNCTD vide order No.F/02/07/2020/S.I/130 dated 03.05.2020, this department directed that all liquor shops/vends/licensees in malls, market complexes and markets shall remain closed vide order no. F.5/IMFL/EX/2020/393-407 dated 03.05.2020. It was also directed that such L-6 and L-8 vends which conform to the criteria prescribed by the MHA in clause-7(ii)(d) of its order dated 01.05.2020 shall remain open from 9.00 AM to 6.30 PM and shall strictly comply with the National Directives for COVID-19 as specified in Annexure-I of the said order. Accordingly, some L-6 & L-8 vends were allowed to open on the basis of undertaking submitted by all the four Government Corporations viz. DSIIDC, DTTDC, DSCSC and DCCWS regarding their adherence to the prescribed criteria.


And whereas, vide same order, the bonded warehouses (L-1 & L-1F) were also allowed to resume operations from 7.00 AM to 6.30 PM subject to strict compliance with the National Directives for COVID-19 Management with 33% strength as per requirement with the remaining persons working from home.

And whereas, with reference to the Order No. 40-3/2020-DM-I(A) dated 17.05.2020 of the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India the Chairperson, State Executive Committee, Delhi Disaster Management Authority, GNCTD has issued fresh guidelines regarding permissible & non-permissible activities in Delhi vide Order No. F.2/07/2020/S.I/partfile/176 dated 18.05.2020.

And whereas, all shopping malls comes under the category of prohibited activity as specified in Clause-1(iv) of the guidelines issued by the Chairperson, State Executive Committee, Delhi Disaster Management Authority, vide aforesaid Order dated 18.05.2020.

And, whereas, as per Clause 3(vii) of order no. F.2/07/2020/S.I/partfile/176 dated 18.05.2020, following directions regarding Shops and Markets have been issued:-

- (a) All markets and market complexes shall remain open on odd-even basis viz. Shops would open on alternate days depending on their shop number. This implies that only 50% of the shops (excluding those selling essential goods) shall be opened. However, shops selling essential goods including books and*




stationery shops, fan shops in markets and market complexes, are permitted to open on all days. Market Associations & DDMA(District-level) and Deputy Labor Commissioner would be responsible to ensure this stipulation.

(b) All stand alone (single) shops, neighborhood (colony) shops and shops in residential complexes are permitted to remain open without any distinction of essential and non-essential.

(c) Social distancing (2 Gaz ki doori) will be maintained in all cases. If social distancing is not maintained by any shop, then the said shop shall be liable to be closed in view of public health hazard involved in containing the spread of COVID-19 pandemic and the shopkeeper shall also be liable for prosecution under the relevant laws.


Now, therefore, with the approval of the Competent Authority, the following directions are hereby issued:-

1. All liquor shops/vends/licenses (L-10) in Malls shall remain closed.
2. All Corporation vends (L-6/L-8) already allowed to operate vide Order No. F.5/IMFL/EX/2020/393-407 dated 03.05.2020 will continue to operate on daily basis from 9.00 AM to 6.30 PM subject to strict compliance of National Directives for COVID 19 Management (Annexure II of MHA's order dated 17.05.2020).
3. Remaining Corporation vends (L-6/L-8) shall operate on odd-even basis as per guidelines specified in Clause 3(vii)(a) of DDMA's Order No. F.2/07/2020/S.I/partfile/176 dated 18.05.2020 subject to strict compliance of National Directives for COVID 19 Management (Annexure II of MHA's order dated 17.05.2020). All four Government Corporations viz. DSIIDC, DTTDC, DSCSC and DCCWS are further directed to take all possible measures including deployment of adequate number of Marshals, proper barricading, e-token etc. in coordination with Delhi Police and local administration.
4. All Private vends (L-7) are not allowed to open their shops without conducting MSR activity. Accordingly, all L-7 licensees are directed to conduct MSR activity between 19th May,2020 to 21stMay,2020. After completion of MSR activity, the licensee shall submit a compliance report to the Assistant Commissioner (L/7), Excise Department along with the undertaking that the shop does not fall under the containment zone. Only after submission of the MSR compliance report and the undertaking from the licensee, the shop shall be allowed to be opened on odd-even basis as per guidelines specified in Clause 3(vii)(a) of DDMA's Order No. F.2/07/2020/S.I/partfile/176dated 18.05.2020 subject to strict compliance of National Directives for COVID 19 Management (Annexure II of MHA's order dated



17.05.2020). In case, any L-7 shop is opened on the basis of any false information, the license of the shop shall be liable to be cancelled.

5. All bonded warehouses shall continue to operate from 7.00AM to 6.30PM subject to strict compliance of National Directives for COVID 19 Management (Annexure II of MHA's order dated 17.05.2020). The Bond Inspectors are directed to ensure strict compliance of the National Directives for COVID 19 Management as specified in Annexure II of MHA's order dated 17.05.2020.
6. It is reiterated that no retail vend or bonded warehouse shall open in containment zones. In case, any retail vend or bonded warehouse allowed to be operationalized, comes under the containment zones in future, the same shall be closed immediately

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
