ORDER

I am pleased to intimate that Govt. of NCT of Delhi vide cabinet decision No. 2158 dated 11.06.2015 has decided to change the charging point of excise duty from existing transport permit level to import permit level and the excise duty is to be deposited by the L-1 licensee when import permit is applied w.e.f. 01.08.2015.

To make it a success, the co-operation of all the stake holder is essential, therefore, the likely steps need to be taken as under:

1. All the L-1 licensee have to keep adequate provisions of money in their bank account to deposit the excise duty at import permit level so the Import permit are approved without any difficulty to facilitate the import of liquor so adequate and continuous liquor is supplied to retail licensees without any difficulty.
2. The Excise Duty on the stock lying on 01.08.2015 with L-1 licensee is to be deposited, therefore, the bank account of L-1 licensee attached with ESCIMS should have adequate amount for the Excise Duty,
3. The L-1 licensee shall ensure that atleast one week stock is maintained in BWH to have adequate and continuous supply of liquor to avoid any untoward incident otherwise strict punitive action under Rule, 89 of Delhi Excise Rules, 2010 shall be taken.
